Crime is increasing in 2013

Report suspicious activity to police, many burglars work in pairs & can be found loitering—even doorknocking to check if site is attended & watching to see when people depart. To then gain entry.
Theft from vehicles is on the increase as well.

Expensive small items are highly sought after such as jewellery, portable computers, top of the range cameras, new phones & obviously cash.

Consider installing a small safe & make sure that it is protected with a motion detector linked to your alarm-try to purchase a product that has protection from fire as well.

Never leave a laptop computer at reception or front of house without it being secured with a Kensington lock.

The majority of forced entries occur on the side or back of properties. Trim bushes to improve visibility, do not leave sheds or garages unlocked or your tools can be used by thieves to break in to your own property.

Make sure you back up all your documents monthly & keep a copy in the fire resistant safe or offsite.

Do not leave bags, purses or expensive items in view of front windows or in the car. Deadlocks are a real deterrent at back or side doors.
